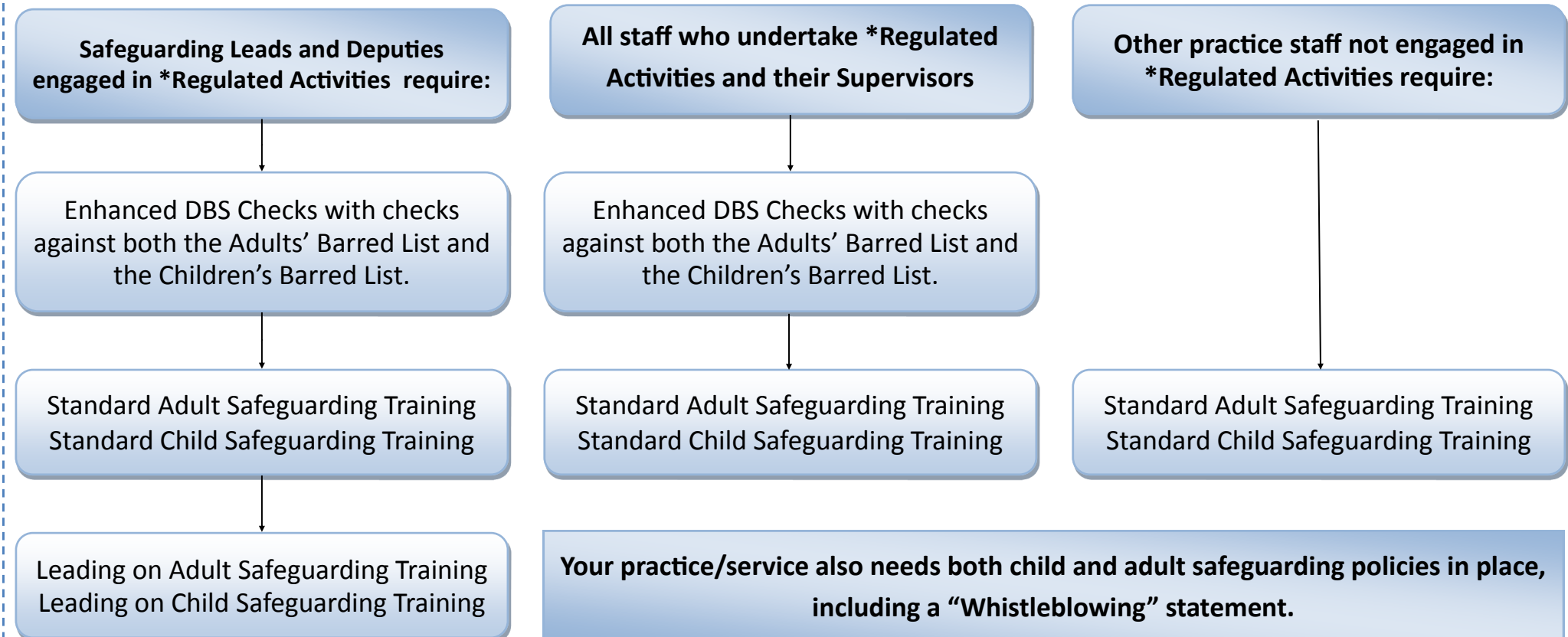


## GP Practices and other Primary Medical Services (PMS) Safeguarding

\*This refers to Regulated Activities as listed in Schedule 1 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 (Regulated Activities) Regulations 2012. The 15 different activities most relevant to GP and other PMS are: treatment of disease, disorder and injury, diagnostic and screening procedures, some surgical procedures, maternity and midwifery services and fitting or removing IUCD's
